

**Key Messages for Hurricane Fiona** Advisory 28: 5:00 AM EDT Wed Sep 21, 2022

- 1. Heavy rains south of Fiona will continue to impact the Turks and Caicos through this morning with additional flooding possible.
- 2. Tropical storm conditions are possible on Bermuda by late Thursday.
- 3. Fiona is expected to affect portions of Atlantic Canada as a powerful hurricane-force cyclone late Friday and Saturday, and could produce significant impacts from high winds, storm surge, and heavy rainfall. Interests in these areas should closely monitor the progress of Fiona and updates to the forecast.
